

Lone Star Skiers @ TSC Final Showdown Whitefish, MT (March 2-9, 2024)

On March 2 - 17 Lone Star skiers (some Los Amigos in the mix too) arrived at Kalispell, MT for a week of skiing and fun at Whitefish Resort with the Texas Ski Council's Final Showdown. 134 skiers from 6 Clubs participated. LSS stayed at The Lodge at Whitefish in the condos looking over Whitefish Lake. The Lodge had an indoor hot tub and pool with a huge outdoor hot tub with magnificent lake and mountain views.

Whitefish - wow what a beautiful place! The softest powdery snow I have ever skied. We could not have picked a better week to be there. The snow stopped early in the week and we had clear sunny days the rest of the week. The locals said that sunny days can be rare. The mountain had 199" of snow to date with 4" of new snow the day we arrived. The 6,817 foot Summit had a 88" base.

Sunday, the TSC Welcome Party at the Grouse Mountain Lodge had appetizers including - fresh vegetables & remoulade, Spanakopita, Seared Beef Tenderloin + horseradish caper aioli & crostini, Lemon Pepper Trout Cakes, and cookies. This event was a nice chance for old ski buddies to get caught up with each other.

Tuesday's Club Dinner was at the Buffalo Café which has a local Whitefish flare. The Dallas Ski club was also having their club dinner. Bison Meatloaf and Elk Tacos were some of the local specials. 
















WE WANT YOU- AS A TRIP DIRECTOR

Trip Director responsibilities:

- Communicate to participants prior and during the trip
- Create the Club Trip Page and Newsletter slides/updates.
- Market the trip. The TD is expected to market their trip by attending Happy Hours,
 email blasts and communication with sister clubs as needed.
- If TSC trip, communicate THROUGH the TSC Trip Coordinator for trip details.
- Plan the Trip Agenda (Club Dinner, Happy Hours, activities, etc.)
- After the trip, a short trip write-up for the newsletter and submit your expense report.
